(i) **Pre-noon Session for**

(a) **For Director/Scientist 'D' Questions-** 200; Marks- 200 (each question of one mark each). Duration 180 Minutes – negative marking 0.5 for wrong answer:

Level of the examination and toughness of question for Director/Scientist 'D' will be highest Questions only in the field of Solar Energy, with three main subjects of Solar Resources, Solar Thermal and Solar Photovoltaic;

(b) **For Assistant Director/Scientist 'B' Questions-** 200; Marks-200 (each question of one mark each) -. Duration 180 Minutes – negative marking 0.5 for wrong answer

Questions only on Solar Energy, toughness may be lowest. The topics three main subjects Solar Resources, Solar Thermal and Solar Photovoltaic;

(ii) **Post-noon Session for**

For Deputy Director / Scientist 'Questions- 200; Marks- 200 (each question of one mark each) -. Duration 180 Minutes – negative marking 0.5 for wrong answer:

Questions Only on Solar Energy, toughness may be medium. The topics three main subjects Solar Resources, Solar Thermal and Solar Photovoltaic;

(The questions will be of multiple choice type,) stickily as per syllabus, with clear cut answers without any ambiguity and suitable for on-line examination/computer based examination, (four options, with three wrong and one correct). No hard copy shall be provided.

The Question Papers may have numerable questions for which the candidate will be permitted to use calculator.

The date of examination shall be notified on NISE Website immediately it is decided. The admit cards of the eligible candidates shall be uploaded on NISE web-site immediately after the finalization of date of examination, and centre of the candidate and other modalities thereon.
