**Response:**

Suryamitra Skill Development Programme is designed with the objective to develop skilled manpower in the field of solar energy particularly in view of huge demand of trained persons to install, operate & maintain the solar photovoltaics (SPV) system under the National Solar Mission. Ministry has launched Suryamitra Skill Development Programme in 2015 and assigned the task of implementation to National Institute of Solar Energy (NISE).

NISE implement the program across the country (PAN India) through empanelled training partners/ Training Centres. Till date more than 50,000 Suryamitra have been trained out of which the placement of the participants is more than 50%. The trained Suryamitra are equipped with skill required to install maintain and operate the Solar PV plants of small and large capacity.

Details of the Trained and placed participants under Suryamitra Skill Development Program is attached at Annexure I.

Ministry of New and Renewable Energy, Government of India, under its scheme, Suryamitra Skill Development Program\* allocated funds to various categories, including Scheduled Tribals. The details of the fund allocated by the Ministry of New and Renewable Energy, Government of India, for Scheduled Tribes participants under Suryamitra Skill Development Program are as follows:

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\*Suryamitra Skill Development Programme is an employment-oriented programme designed with the objective to develop skilled manpower in the field of solar energy particularly in view of huge demand of trained persons to install, operate & maintain the solar photovoltaics (SPV) system under the National Solar Mission. The trained Suryamitra are equipped with skill required to install maintain and operate the Solar PV plants of small and large capacity. The programme is the implementing institute for National Institute of Solar Energy.

†Suryamitra Skill Development Program for FY 2021-22 is ongoing.

Suryamitra programme is conducted nationwide through a training partner in a batch of 30 participants. There are no specific reservation guidelines for the participants in the batch based on their category, however, NISE encourages the enrollment of the participants from Scheduled Cast/ Scheduled Tribes/ Rural youth and women candidates.

The funds allocated for FY 2019-20 and FY 2020-21 were mostly utilized. However, the Programme for FY 2021-22 is ongoing and the utilization report will be submitted to MNRE as soon as the funds are released to the concern training centre/partner based on the satisfactory completion of the batch/batches.

- c) **The details of the amount of funds allocated for skill development and certification programme of various tribes across the country including Chhattisgarh during the last three years?**

**Response:** The details of the funds allocation and utilisation under Suryamitra Skill Development Program are attached at Annexure I. There is no segregation of the funds allocated amongst the states, however the funds utilized in Chhattisgarh under this program during last three years are Rs 41,88,561.

The Suryamitra Skill Development Programme is designed with the objective to develop skilled manpower in the field of solar energy particularly in view of huge demand of trained persons to install, operate & maintain the solar photovoltaics (SPV) system under the National Solar Mission. National Institute of Solar Energy (NISE) is given the responsibility to implement the program across the country. NISE implement the program through the empaneled training centers (TC) throughout the country. In order to ensure the proper implementation of the program, NISE has well established monitoring mechanism. The details of the monitoring mechanism are given below:

- All the TC's will have to equipped center with IP based camera in the training room, laboratory and hostel mess. The TC will provide the URL of IP camera so that the training program can be monitored from NISE time to time. The TC keeps the recording and images of IP camera for entire batch(es).
- NISE officers visit the TC during the batch duration to ensure the quality of the program.
- Furthermore, Aadhar Enabled Biometric Attendance System (AEBAS) portal is made mandatory in order to ensure the attendance of the Suryamitra participants for all the states (except for states such as Assam, Meghalaya, and Jammu & Kashmir where Aadhaar card is not available/used).

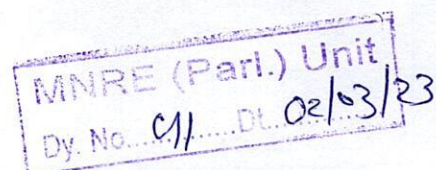

- (i) The TC must be an Institute/ Engineering College/ Polytechnic College/ ITI/ NGO/Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Kendra (PMKK) or any other affiliated skill development centre with proper infrastructure.
- (ii) TC must have training experience in the renewable energy/ solar energy.
- (iii) The TC must have at least one MoU/Tie-up with Industries for industrial on job training.
- (iv) The TC must have valid centre affiliation from NSDC to conduct training as per the relevant QP i.e. solar PV installer SGJ/Q0101.
- (v) The TC shall have 2 trainers per centre and at least one of them shall be certified as Training of Trainer (ToT) from SCGJ to conduct solar training as per the relevant SCGJ Qualification Pack.
- (vi) TC must have well equipped laboratory, classroom facilities and residential facilities.

### 2.3 Process of Shortlisting the TCs

- (a) NISE will form a **Technical Evaluation Committee (TEC)** duly approved by the competent authority to evaluate the response submitted by the TCs against this EoI.
- (b) The TEC will evaluate the responses submitted by the TCs as per following technical response scoring criteria:
